

## INTERNATIONAL NETWORKING PATH

### Context

The International networking paths are fora in which partners have the possibility to exchange practices and information to facilitate the sharing of knowledge and cooperation, as well as specific moments to favor the emerging of joint policies and initiatives. These Fora will bring together the LAs targeted by the project and more. In fact, this WP will also be essential to expand the borders of the network beyond the core group and include additional stakeholders for a further exchange of newly acquired knowledges and experiences.

### Objectives

LAs and NGOs have identified key actors, such as Associations of Local and Regional Authorities and CSOs who are invited to participate to the "international networking paths", to give a chance to LAs to interact with their counterparts (NGOs) and integrate additional knowledge to the one already developed within the core group.

The international networking path is a chance for partners to meet and reflect on common paths. Indeed, partners and external stakeholders will discuss on policy harmonization, project integration and local-to-local cooperation. The meetings should also allow the different stakeholder to discuss about European migrant issues and challenges with the possibility to take common positions and political statements addressed to the European Institutions.

The event in Amadora also allows to conduct the mid-term monitoring of pilot projects.
